FALO File Guidelines

Name: Use your name for the title of the page. You don't need to include it as one of your descriptive elements.

Basic Character Info: Key fields that should be on your character profile include character race, gender, homeland, and profession/class. Feel free to add more. In fact, it's advisable that you provide at least five things about you that will help people get a quick feel for your character.

Photo: Include a photo of your character.

Background: Herein is recorded the story of your life, or at least a brief summing-up. This section should be between 250 and 650 words with 400 to 500 being ideal. Include what you want other people to know about your character—what you would hope someone would tell them about you before introducing them to you and written from that perspective. What is considered important will vary from person to person, and the best way to generate ideas is to look at existing character profiles. Some things to consider are:

- How you came to be a part of this clan and a little about who you were before
- Important relationships
- A bit more about your homeland
- Driving goals or life quests
- Significant choices that made you who you are
- Unique features or practices of your character

You may not wish to include any information that is secret as it is often hard for people who read character profiles to remember what is public knowledge and what is not.

Other Information: Consider including additional photos and links to other character information (e.g. journals, stories, etc.).
